# **Remits for A P Teams**

The Terms of Reference ( T o R ) we issued earlier provided guidelines applicable to all sectors . Following enquiries from some A P Coordinators, we are sending out this note , to specify the remit for each A P Team , sector by sector . As you will see , some remits are rather self-evident , others are less so . We hope this note will be helpful .

In this note , we have also highlighted the need to consciously build synergies among the different sectors , so as to avoid operating as sectoral silos .

We also wish to use this opportunity to emphasise again the importance of providing data in all A P assessments and findings . Please , illustrate and buttress your reviews and assessments with relevant data .This will provide us with necessary validation , accurate perspectives and useful comparisons .

### 1. <u>A P Team</u>, Economy

You are requested to review , assess and provide recommendations on the overall economic situation in Acoliland . Needless to say , the economy constitutes an overarching reality which impacts on everything else in the society .

Whereas you should look out for synergies with all sectors , of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Agriculture , Private Sector & Enterprise , Youth , Skilling , Education , Environment , and Health .

# 2. <u>A P Team</u>, Agriculture.

You are requested to review , assess and provide recommendations on the sector of Agriculture , broadly conceived . This rubric encompasses , *inter alia* : crop farming ; various activities under animal husbandry ; fish farming ; bee keeping ; agro-forestry ; agribusiness ; cooperatives ; and the shift in seasonal patterns . Please look out for synergies with other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Economy , Private Sector & Enterprise , Education , Environment , and Skilling .

# 3. <u>A P Team , Land</u> .

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key aspects of the vexed question of land in Acoliland ; these issues include : land-ownership and tenure ; land-usage ; land-sale ; land-grabbing ; and land-disputes . Next to human capital , this is perhaps the most important remaining asset in Acoli society today .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Economy , Agriculture , Environment , Private Sector & Enterprise , Culture & Heritage , and Youth .

4.<u>A P Team , Pre-Primary, Primary & Secondary Education</u> . You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key aspects of lower and middle education . This includes insights on issues of : equitable access to quality education ; rural and urban schools ; public and private education ; the kind and quality of education on offer ; co-curricular activities ; knowledge and practice of Lwo culture & heritage ; inculcation of critical life values , such as discipline , work ethic , honesty , team spirit , respect , solidarity , knowledge of right & wrong , manners , etc.

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Family & Parenting , Youth , Culture & Heritage , Skilling , Agriculture , and Higher Education .

5. A P Team , Higher & Tertiary Education .

You are requested to review, assess and make recommendations on key aspects of participation of Acoli community in higher education, within and outside the region. Some of the issues for review might include : higher education institutions within the region ; access to higher education ; the kind and quality of higher education on offer ; cost of higher education.

Please look out for synergies with other sectors ; of particular interest might be the connections with the sectors of Economy , Primary & Secondary Education , Youth , Skilling , Private Sector & Enterprise , Leadership .

#### 6.A P Team , Skilling .

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key aspects of Skilling at all levels and in all categories .

Please look out for synergies with other sectors ; of particular interest might be the connections with the sectors of Primary & Secondary Education , Higher & Tertiary Education , Youth , Agriculture , Private Sector & Enterprise , and Economy .

7. <u>A P Team , Family & Parenting</u> .

You are requested to review , assess , and make recommendations on the crisis of the family and parenting in Acoli society today .

In so doing , you may consider the following . Functioning family unit appears to be in deep crisis in our community . Serious parenting has become rare . And , we are witnessing the ever disappearing role of men within the family .Yet , historically , Acoli society was renowned for strong families , well-defined roles for both men and women in the home , and systematic joint parenting . These were the traditional foundational pillars of the society .

The issues for review should therefore include : family cohesion ; break-up of families ; division of labour and responsibilities within the home , particularly between fathers and mothers ; the fastdisappearing role of fathers within the home ; increasingly , the massive family responsibilities thrust on the exclusive shoulders of mothers ; upbringing of children , including inculcation of traditional life values of discipline , hard work , honesty , respect , love of education , solidarity , and manners .

Please look out for synergies with other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Culture & Heritage , Education , Youth , Leb Lwo , Agriculture , and Economy .

# 8.A P Team, Health.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key aspects of the health situation in the community , taken holistically . Your review should also include the deeply worrying issues of generalised psychosocial trauma within the community , the epidemic of alcoholism ( and other substance abuse ), and poor nutrition .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Family & Parenting , Youth , Education , Culture & Heritage , Agriculture , and Economy .

# 9.A P Team Youth .

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key aspects of the youth question in Acoli society today .

In so doing , consider this . Our youth should naturally be the backbone of any enterprise for renewal and rebuilding of the community . But what happens when the backbone is broken and

fragile ? Your central task is to design strategies for turning this potential army of spoilers into a powerful force for good , a force for reconstruction , a force for community renewal and advancement .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be the sectors of Family & Parenting , Education , Health , Skilling ,Agriculture , Private Sector & Enterprise , Culture & Heritage , and Leadership .

### 10.A P Team, Oil & Gas.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on the impact of the exploitation of the new-found oil and gas resources on the economy and development of Acoliland .

We understand that in this sector , a lot of ground has already been traversed in an earlier report , also prepared under the stewardship of Prof. Morris Ogenga Latigo . In that case , two things are now needed . First , an update , incorporating developments subsequent to the earlier report . And , second , and most important , a clear strategy to ensure that a policy of fair play is put in place concerning oil and gas resources .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections to the sectors of Economy , Private Sector & Enterprise , Environment , Higher Education , and Skilling .

# 11.<u>A P Team , Environment</u>.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key issues concerning the protection , management and restoration of the natural environment in Acoliland .

In so doing , consider this .There has been massive destruction of the natural environment in the Acoli region , largely , but not exclusively , due to indiscriminate deforestation to feed the charcoal industry . The longterm consequences of this development are now manifesting all around us . In charting the future livelihood and wellbeing of the community , this is an issue of great concern .

Two other developments are contributing prominently to the degradation of natural environment in Acoliland : the casual , ubiquitous disposal of plastics and other waste ; and the increasing unregulated use of chemicals in agriculture . We request you to address these concerns as well .

Please be on the look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be the sectors of Economy , Agriculture , Private Sector & Enterprise , Youth , Culture & Heritage , and Leadership .

12.A P Teams, Private Sector & Enterprise.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on attracting and growing private investment and enterprise in Acoli region .

In so doing , you may consider this .There is a modest and fragile base of home-grown private enterprise in the region ; however , sourcing capital remains a tall order for local entrepreneurs . Outside investment is barely trickling in , in part due to the unavailability and unreliability of power , but also because of widespread interminable disputes over land . Meanwhile , Diaspora investment is greatly frustrated , encountering many impediments and pitfalls in its path . These are some of the major challenges impeding the growth of private sector in the region .

Several issues stand out for review ; these include : access to capital for local entrepreneurs ; reliable and affordable power for industry ; availability of wrangles-free land ; availability of dependable labour ; availability of skilled manpower ; proactive outreach strategy to attract outside investment ; creating the environment and conditions that are welcoming and attractive for Diaspora investment .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Economy , Agriculture , Skilling , Education , Youth , and Environment .

# 13. <u>A P Teams</u>, Culture and Heritage.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on how to revive knowledge and practice of the culture of the Central Lwo ( Acoli ) , as a robust and dynamic heritage .

In so doing , you may consider the following . Historically , the Central Lwo ( Acoli ) have one of the richest and most enviable endowments of culture and civilisation anywhere in the world . Witness , for example , the multiplicity of dances and dance-forms ; the many musical forms and musical instruments ; ododo ; koc ; a very rich language (" Leb Lwo kuu ", quoting Lapwony J P Abe ) ; poetry ; unique and incredible cuisine ; indigenous sports ; wellorganised quasi-democratic polities under the clan and chief ; wellorganised and structured upbringing of children ; well-organised homesteads ; organised land usage ; conflict resolution and reconciliation mechanisms ; a comprehensive body of ethical norms and values for the society ; overarching norm of the public good ; and norms of warfare . The list goes on .

The big tragedy is that most of this heritage is crumbling and disappearing before our very eyes .

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be connections with the sectors of Family & Parenting , Leb Lwo , Education , Youth , and Leadership .

#### 14.<u>A P Team, Leb Lwo</u>.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on how to revive the speaking , reading , writing and publishing of Leb Lwo as a living and thriving language . And , how to deploy Leb Lwo as an important tool for renewal and advancement of Acoli society .

In so doing , consider this . Leb Lwo is a very rich , deep and beautiful language .( " Leb Lwo kuu", quoting Lapwony J P Abe ). Sadly , the reading , writing , publishing and proper speaking of Leb Lwo ( Acoli ) has deteriorated considerably .

Also , language is an invaluable tool for organising , processing , and structuring information , and thereby unleashing radical advancement . How can we deploy our language in the efforts to halt and reverse decline in Acoli society ?

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be the connections with the sectors of Culture & Heritage, Family & Parenting, Education, Youth, and Leadership.

# 15.A P Team , Leadership .

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on key issues affecting leadership in Acoli society today , at all levels and in all categories . How can we build strong , farsighted , selfless leadership , committed to promoting unity , shared destiny and the common good within the community ?

In so doing , you may consider this . Today Acoli society is very much hobbled by a particularly chronic and acute weakness : the dearth and poverty of leadership across the board . This is hurting the community terribly . Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be the connections with the sectors of Culture & Heritage ; Family & Parenting ; Youth ; Leb Lwo .

### 16.<u>A P Team, Diaspora</u>.

You are requested to review , assess and make recommendations on how to maximise the engagement and contribution of the Diaspora to the enterprise of renewal and rebuilding at home . Among other things , you should explore what enabling environment and conditions need to be put in place at home , in order to promote and facilitate such participation , contribution and investment .

In so doing , you may consider the following . The Acoli Diaspora is critically important , it is an indispensable asset for the community ; this for several reasons .

Our brothers and sisters in the Diaspora have retained a different mindset from what currently predominates at home (Paco); they have been spared the massive societal trauma that has left big scarring impact on the people at home (Paco); outside exposure has opened their eyes (oyabo wang-gi) to many things and perspectives; they have been embedded in open and democratic societies; they are operating in competitive societies, with exacting standards and high expectations; they have acquired invaluable expertise and skills; they have modest resources at their disposal; and, above all, most of them are eager to "do something back home " - - " timo gin mo Paco " .

How can we harness and channel these veritable assets into the allimportant enterprise of reorganising , renewing and rebuilding Acoli society ?

Please look out for synergies with the other sectors ; of particular interest might be the sectors of Economy , Private Sector & Enterprise , Education , Skilling , Youth , and Leadership .
