## The Call for Doro Paco

## (Revised)

**Background** . On 13 June , 2020 , a special convocation of Acoli elders took place at Gang Kal (the seat of Ker Kwaro Acoli) in Gulu , under the auspices of Wang-oo, with the support of Ker Kwaro Acoli and Acoli Religious Leaders Peace Initiative (ARLPI). The elders in attendance included : the Prime Minister of Ker Kwaro Acoli (Hon. Ambrose Olaa); Archbishop John Baptist Odama; Bishop MacBaker Ochola II; Bishop Benoni Y. Ogwal-Abwang; Rwot Okwonga Yusuf Adek; Mego Gladys Oyat; Ladit Apollo Lawoko; Ambassador David Mwaka; Professor Hon J. J. Otim; Mego Rosalba Ato Olwa; Vicar General , Monseigneur Matthew Odong; Hon. Zachary Olum; Ladit Peter Oweka; Hon. J. L. Okello-Okello (Chair , Wang-oo); and Ambassador Olara Otunnu . Also attending were Hon Okin P.P. Ojara (Chair , APG); Hon. Mego Betty Aol Ocan (LoP); Hon Lilly Adong; RDC, Gulu (Major Santo Okot Lapolo) ; LC 5 Chair , Gulu (Ojara Mapinduzi); and LC 5 Chair , Omoro (). The meeting was chaired by Justice Galdino Moro Okello .

In their reflection, the elders were particularly struck and moved by the sheer magnitude of the fundamental breakdown (*too paco*), societal malaise and multifaceted trauma which have taken a deep and scarring toll on Acoli society. This painful legacy of over twenty years of war and camp internment in Acoliland manifestly calls for extraordinary attention and extraordinary action of redress.

In view of this unprecedented situation , a key outcome of the meeting at Gang Kal was therefore the decision to constitute a council of elders to serve as a special convocation for *doro paco* .

**Name for the consultative convocation**. This consultative convocation of elders shall be known as "Council of Elders for *Doro Paco*" ("Doro Paco", for short).

**The role of Doro Paco**. The role of Doro Paco is to provide reflection, guidance and direction on fundamental and pivotal issues affecting the wellbeing and future of Acoliland.

**Composition of Doro Paco**. Doro Paco is to be composed of men and women of serious moral conviction and integrity, broad experience and insights , humility and objectivity , who share a selfless preoccupation and burden for the wellbeing and future of Acoliland . These men and women are to be invited , in their individual and personal capacities , from both the homeland community and Acoli diaspora . Ideally , this should be a rather select and relatively small convocation of elders .

Auspices for Doro Paco. Like the convocation of 13 June, 2020, in the immediate, Doro Paco will convene its consultations under the auspices of Wang-oo, with the support of Ker Kwaro Acoli, Acoli Religious Leaders Peace Initiative (ARLPI), and the collective of the eight LC5 Chairs whose jurisdictions cover Acoliland.

**Preoccupations for Doro Paco**. The preoccupations for reflection, guidance and direction by Doro Paco will encompass overarching, pivotal issues, that impact on the wellbeing and future of Acoliland. These include the following critical concerns.

- 1. Addressing the deep and widespread breakdown of fundamentals (*too paco*) in Acoli society today, in all its manifestations.
- 2. Reviving and promoting Acoli civilization, as it relates to culture and the arts, traditions and moral values, history and language, etc.
- 3. Promoting holistic , quality and equitable development , with particular focus on the crucial sectors of health , education , agriculture and land development ; in effect , charting a reconstruction agenda for rebuilding Acoliland .
- 4. Building acute awareness, responsibility and stewardship for the protection and conservation of the natural environment in Acoliland.
- 5. Addressing issues of land (land development, land disputes, land-grabbing, etc).
- 6. Combatting all attempts to foment futile internal divisions and conflicts within Acoli society ; this has been perpetrated chiefly through the cynical manipulation of confessional and clan

affiliations, and also the promotion of east-west divide. Doro Paco will work diligently to build respect, solidarity and harmony among the Acoli community as one, undivided people, sharing a common heritage and a common destiny.

- 7. Promoting and inculcating honest, service-centred and values-based leadership, in all sectors and at all levels of society. Doro Paco may convene special sessions for reflection and discussion with particular categories of leaders, as necessary.
- 8. Calling out unacceptable personal and official conduct , especially by leaders , and calling to order those concerned .
- 9. Restoring cohesion and joint responsibility in Acoli families . This means , among other imperatives , re-engagement of men to fully reassume their responsibilities and duties within families . This also entails restoring priority to serious parenting , to ensure proper upbringing of children and youth , in a nurturing environment , marked by education , discipline and moral values . All these responsibilities and duties must be jointly shouldered by both the men and women in the families .
- 10. Reversing the trends of rampant social ills, which are today wreaking untold havoc in Acoliland; these major and rampant social ills include corruption, alcoholism, easy resort to violence, youth delinquency, teenage pregnancy, etc.
- 11. Joining hands (*teno kwot*) between the homeland community and Acoli diaspora, in order to stimulate much-needed reconstruction and development, and tackle together the grave challenges facing Acoliland today.
- 12. Steadfastly working to ensure mutual respect, good neighbourliness and harmonious rapport with neighbouring communities, and all other communities in Uganda.

**Overarching priority on the younger generations .** In all this , there is an imperative . In designing responses to the preoccupations outlined above , it is imperative that , in all strategies and interventions , top priority is given to the situation of the younger generations and the youth ; to their training and development , their engagement and mentoring , their discipline and leadership . Quite simply , the younger generations and the youth have to be at the centre of rebuilding Acoli society . This is absolutely necessary ; it is also the only way to ensure the sustainability and future of this enterprise.

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Postscript.

- a. Ideally, Doro Paco should be a very select, small convocation, the full compliment of which should not exceed thirty-five elders (35) at any given time; this is inclusive of diaspora members.
- b. Doro Paco should have a Chair and two Vice-Chairs .
- c. There should be a Steering Committee for Doro Paco, consisting of seven (7) members, with a Chair and Vice-Chair. The role of the Steering Committee should be to plan and organise the convening, work and deliberations of Doro Paco.
- d. Certain leaders (e.g. LC5 Chairs , APG Chair , etc ) may be invited to attend particular sessions of Doro Paco , as necessary , in their ex officio capacities .
- e. Needless to say, all deliberations and communications should be conducted in Lwo. It may be necessary, however, to translate certain documents into English, mainly for the benefit of some younger persons in the diaspora, who may not be conversant with Lwo.
